Lake Catholic is not only looking to advance to the regional finals, but avenge a playoff exit in 2024 as the Cougars will face Glenville in a Division IV, Region 13 showdown on Nov. 14.

The Tarblooders, which defeated Lake Catholic, 28-0, in the postseason last year, is led by Chris Newell, Cincere Johnson. Marc Givler and Tony Gerdeman among a host of others.

Coach Tedd Ginn has spent decades establishing Glenville as one of the top programs year in and year out in the state.

The Cougars are a difficult team to prepare for because they come at opponents in a variety of ways. Offensively, the big guys up front set the tone for the running game led by Nathan Zappitelli and David Ianni. Danny Zmorowski has been a stud out of the backfield. Pete Malchesky and Marty Gibbons make plays anytime they are one the field and Tyler Hribar has emerged as critical piece of the Lake Catholic puzzle.

"It started against (NDCL) and the guys played hard and attacked and got to the ball. I was very proud of the effort against a talented Streetsboro team."

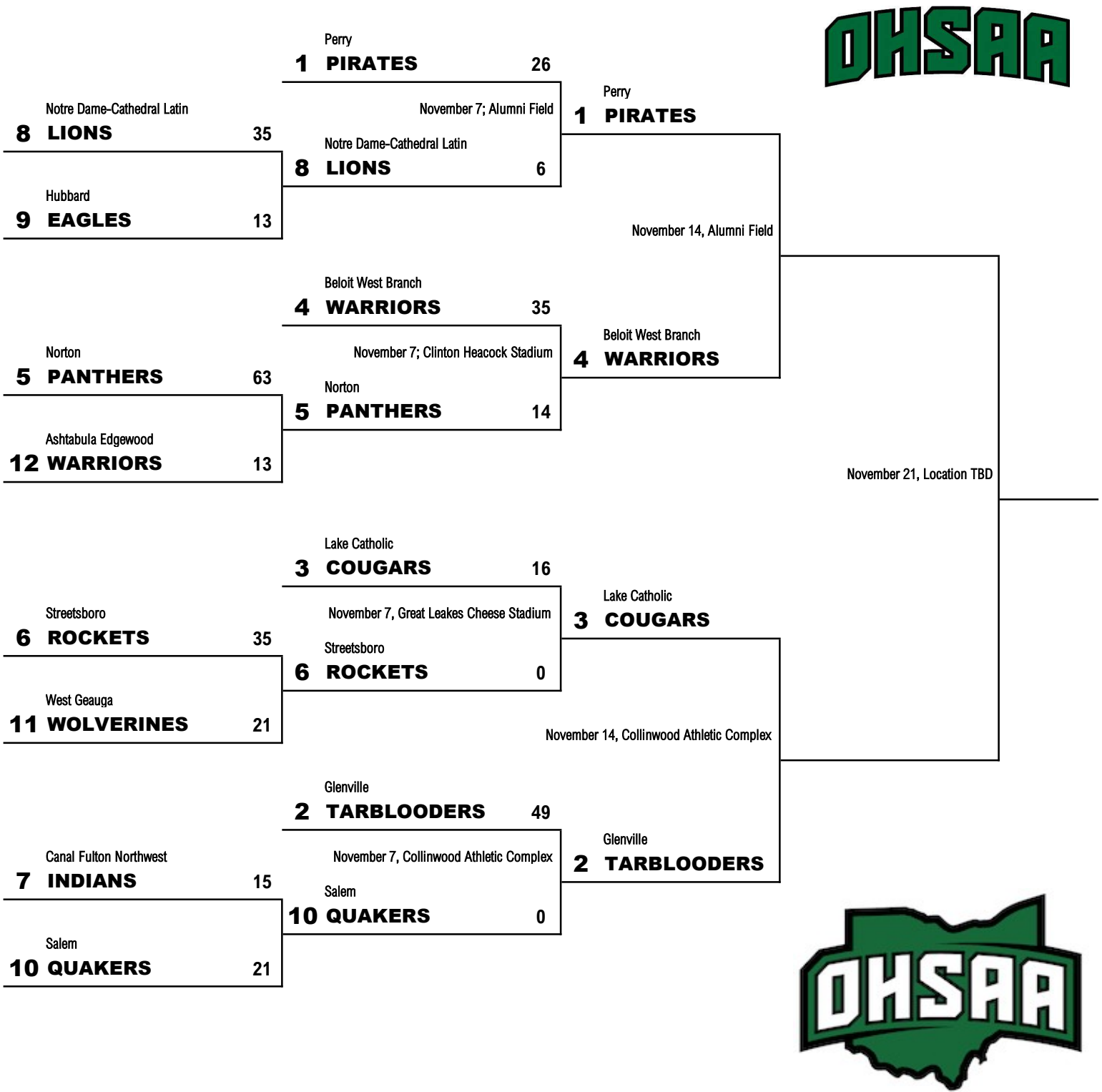

If time permits, credentials will be mailed to individual media members, otherwise all passes will be made available at Media Will Call at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium.

MEDIA POLICY

The press box at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is located atop the east side (home side) bleachers. Separate coaches' boxes are available for team personnel only. Media who need working space in the press box should request it through Erik Schroeder or Lea Crowley. Seating will be limited in the press box. For featured games, media members will be assigned seats in the press seating area and seating assignments will be posted throughout the press box.

FIELD MEDIA POLICY

Due to limited space in the press box at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium, approved media and photographers will be permitted on the sidelines and are expected to honor all sideline policies. Media members and photographers are not allowed in the team bench areas, locker rooms, or other restricted areas in the stadium.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Credentials for photographers will be issued to those representing newspapers, bona fide publications, and other periodicals by Erik Schroeder or Lea Crowley. Please make requests in advance. All photographers are expected to honor all sideline policies and are not permitted in the team bench areas, locker rooms, or other restricted areas within Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium without prior, written authorization from the Lake Catholic Athletic Department.

MEDIA WILL CALL

Approved media or photo credentials can be obtained at the Media Will Call window located at the northwest ticket gate of Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium. The Media Will Call window opens approximately 90 minutes before the game.

LOCKER ROOM POLICY

Lake Catholic High School maintains a closed locker room policy for media at both Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium and on the Lake Catholic High School campus.

WEEKLY GAME NOTES

Lake Catholic football game notes will be available approximately 24 hours prior to kickoff each week and copies will be available in press box prior to each game. TV / RADIO

Local TV crews and radio crews should request permission to broadcast games at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium through the Lake Catholic Athletic Department at least 72 hours prior to kickoff. Crews will have assigned seats in the press box. The Cougars Broadcasting Network and is the official Lake Catholic student streaming broadcast of home games and Spectrum TV is the official television partner of the OHSAA. Both media entities will receive priority seating in the press box.

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium

HOME OF THE LAKE CATHOLIC COUGARS

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is the home to the Lake Catholic Cougars varsity football team. The facility was renovated prior to the start of the 2006 season and has been updated and enhanced prior to 2014 and 2023 seasons.

The stadium is often referred to as 'The JTO'.

As part of the original renovations of the JTO, the Osborne family earmarked \$750,000 to the Mentor School District to install an artificial turf football field, a new rubberized track and a new scoreboard at the stadium. Lake Catholic High School also donated \$300,000 to the initial project and the Cougars played the first-ever football game in the renovated stadium on Aug. 26, 2006 against the Euclid Panthers. The facility has a total capacity of 8,000.

The win marked the third shutout of the season for Lake Catholic's defense.

The Cougars will move on to play Glenville in a regional semifinal Nov. 14 at a site to be determined. The Tarblooders eliminated the Cougars in the same round last year, 28-0.

Danny Zmowski racked up 137 yards and a touchdown on 22 carries, but the story of the night was the defense.

Lake Catholic senior Pete Malchesky pounced on a fumble at the Streetsboro 14. A 10-yard run for a touchdown by Zmowski was negated by a holding penalty, and the Cougars (9-2) settled for a 36-yard field goal by junior Gavyn Fredriks for a 3-0 lead.

After Lake Catholic forced a punt, Zmowski carried on six of eight plays on a 71-yard drive, highlighted by a 34-yard run and pushed across the goal line on fourth-and-goal at the 1 on the first play of the second quarter as the Cougars extended their lead to 10-0.

Cougars QB Max Pisano found Malchesky open for a score to push the lead to 16-0 and the defense did the rest. Lake Catholic finished with 226 total yards, 220 on the ground, led by Zmowski.

Senior Marty Loncar intercepted a pass on the first play of Streetsboro's next possession, and although Lake Catholic would later punt with 1:47 left, the defense kept the Rockets bottled up.

The Cougars' defense held Streetsboro to 120 yards, just 48 rushing. Lake Catholic junior DE Michael Barnes had three sacks on the night.

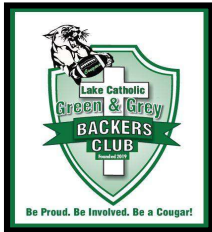

Changes to OHSAA Playoffs

There will be four less qualifiers in each region in the 2025 Ohio high school football playoffs.

The Ohio High School Athletic Association announced in June that the number of football teams qualifying for the 2025 postseason will be reduced from 16 to 12 per region.

The top four seeds in each region will receive first-round byes beginning this season.

The first three rounds will be hosted by higher seeds instead of the first two rounds, which would allow a top-four seed to still get two home playoff games.

With the top four seeds receiving byes, lower seeds will visit higher seeds in the first round.

The No. 5 seed in each region will host the No. 12 seed, No. 6 will host No. 11, No. 7 will host No. 10 and No. 8 will host No. 9.

The OHSAA expanded to 16 teams per region in 2021. In the four years of those expanded playoffs:

- No. 1 seeds were 111-1, with the lone win coming in 2021.
- No. 2 seeds were 105-7 while
- No. 3 seeds were 101-11.

Last fall, No. 1 seeds went 28-0 across seven divisions with an average margin of victory of 42 points.

Expanded playoffs began in 1985. At the beginning of that season, The OHSAA doubled the number of playoff teams per region, moving from two to four teams per region.

In 1999 expansion of the playoff format occurred again, as eight schools per region qualified for the playoffs, creating a regional quarterfinal round.

Early in 2020, the OHSAA approved a proposal from the Ohio High School Football Coaches Association to expand to 12 teams per region.

(In 2020, the OHSAA made pandemic adjustments to the football post season, allowing all schools to participate)

In the last four seasons, the OHSAA used a format that allowed up to 16 teams in each region to qualify for the playoffs

The team became just the fifth team in program history to be undefeated during the regular season (1972, 1990, 1992, 1996 and 2024).

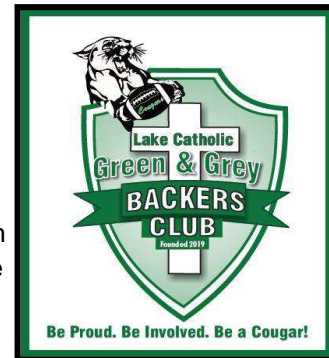
