Cougars Kickoff Notes

Lake Catholic will look to build momentum off a shutout win at Elyria Catholic as the Cougars travel to Parma to face longtime foe Padua on Oct. 10.

The Bruins have struggled this year to a 1-6 record albeit against a difficult schedule that includes four teams at 6-1. It has been tough sledding on both sides of the ball for Padua, but special teams have been a bright spot led by Caleb Zolkowski as a kicker and punter.

Lake Catholic is 5-2 and currently second in Division IV, Region 13. The Cougars got their first shutout of the season in a Week 7 victory at EC. Marty Loncar is a standout on defense and wherever he is called upon to play. The offense goes as the talented offensive line goes led by Nathan Zappitelli and David Iannini. Danny Zmorowski is emerging as one of the area's top producers out of the backfield. Max Pisano spreads the ball around from the QB position.

Expansion of the North Coast Conference



The North Coast Conference, which is starting its football conference schedule this year, will have eight members for all sports by the fall of 2027.



Beginning this year - the 2025-26 school year - Benedictine High School will be a full-time member of the NCC in all boys sports except football. The Bengals will become part of the football scheduling starting in the fall of 2027.



That same season (fall of 2027), the Lutheran West Longhorns will also join the NCC as a full-time member. The conference has nine total schools, with Beaumont, an all-girls school, allows for balanced scheduling across the league in all sports.

MEDIA POLICY

The press box at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is located atop the east side (home side) bleachers. Separate coaches' boxes are available for team personnel only. Media who need working space in the press box should request it through Erik Schroeder or Lea Crowley. Seating will be limited in the press box. For featured games, media members will be assigned seats in the press seating area and seating assignments will be posted throughout the press box.

FIELD MEDIA POLICY

Due to limited space in the press box at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium, approved media and photographers will be permitted on the sidelines and are expected to honor all sideline policies. Media members and photographers are not allowed in the team bench areas, locker rooms, or other restricted areas in the stadium.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Credentials for photographers will be issued to those representing newspapers, bona fide publications, and other periodicals by Erik Schroeder or Lea Crowley. Please make requests in advance. All photographers are expected to honor all sideline policies and are not permitted in the team bench areas, locker rooms, or other restricted areas within Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium without prior, written authorization from the Lake Catholic Athletic Department.

MEDIA WILL CALL

Approved media or photo credentials can be obtained at the Media Will Call window located at the northwest ticket gate of Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium. The Media Will Call window opens approximately 90 minutes before the game.

LOCKER ROOM POLICY

Lake Catholic High School maintains a closed locker room policy for media at both Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium and on the Lake Catholic High School campus.

WEEKLY GAME NOTES

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium

HOME OF THE LAKE CATHOLIC COUGARS

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is the home to the Lake Catholic Cougars varsity football team. The facility was renovated prior to the start of the 2006 season and has been updated and enhanced prior to 2014 and 2023 seasons.

The stadium is often referred to as 'The JTO'.

As part of the original renovations of the JTO, the Osborne family earmarked \$750,000 to the Mentor School District to install an artificial turf football field, a new rubberized track and a new scoreboard at the stadium. Lake Catholic High School also donated \$300,000 to the initial project and the Cougars played the first-ever football game in the renovated stadium on Aug. 26, 2006 against the Euclid Panthers. The facility has a total capacity of 8,000.

Week 7, 2025 - Review and Summary

LAKE CATHOLIC BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN, PITCH FIRST SHUTOUT

Coming off a loss to Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy last week, Lake Catholic was looking for a rebound game in a big way.

Mission accomplished.

The Cougars snapped Elyria Catholic's three-game winning streak with a 26-0 road victory Oct. 3.

Lake Catholic (5-2, 1-1 NCC) rushed for 159 yards in the first half and Elyria Catholic (3-4, 1-1 NCC) was unable to counter. The Cougars pulled away with 12 points in the final five minutes of the first half.

Junior running back Danny Zmorowski led the way for Lake Catholic with 96 yards and a touchdown. Sophomore quarterback Max Pisano added 89 yards and two scores.

Pisano started the night off with a 54-yard touchdown run on Lake Catholic's third play from scrimmage. The sophomore's run went for more yards than Elyria Catholic's first-half total (37).

The Cougars took the lead just 3:38 into the game and never fell behind.

Both teams traded punts before Lake Catholic's ground game got going once again. Zmorowski broke off a 33-yard run and later capped off the drive with a 1-yard score with 4:56 remaining in the half.

Following another Panthers' punt, Lake Catholic was unable to find the end zone, but a 26-yard field goal from Gavyn Fredriks extended the lead to 17 with 30 seconds left. The Cougars put a safety on the board on the ensuing kickoff to take a 19-0 halftime lead.

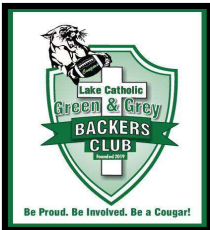

Prior to accepting the head coaching job with the Cougars, Gibbons spent the 2017 season as the defensive coordinator at Villa Angela – St. Joseph. Before his stint at VASJ, he assisted with defensive backs at Notre Dame College (2016) and also helped his brother, Mike Gibbons, at Medina Highland (2015).

Gibbons played collegiately at John Carroll University. He is the youngest of nine children for John & Patty Gibbons. His brothers, Tom & Mike have coaching roots in Northeast Ohio, as does his brother-in-law, Tom Lombardo.

Changes to OHSAA Playoffs

There will be four less qualifiers in each region in the 2025 Ohio high school football playoffs.

The Ohio High School Athletic Association announced in June that the number of football teams qualifying for the 2025 postseason will be reduced from 16 to 12 per region.

The top four seeds in each region will receive first-round byes beginning this season.

The first three rounds will be hosted by higher seeds instead of the first two rounds, which would allow a top-four seed to still get two home playoff games.

With the top four seeds receiving byes, lower seeds will visit higher seeds in the first round.

The No. 5 seed in each region will host the No. 12 seed, No. 6 will host No. 11, No. 7 will host No. 10 and No. 8 will host No. 9.

The OHSAA expanded to 16 teams per region in 2021. In the four years of those expanded playoffs:

- No. 1 seeds were 111-1, with the lone win coming in 2021.
- No. 2 seeds were 105-7 while
- No. 3 seeds were 101-11.

Last fall, No. 1 seeds went 28-0 across seven divisions with an average margin of victory of 42 points.

Expanded playoffs began in 1985. At the beginning of that season, The OHSAA doubled the number of playoff teams per region, moving from two to four teams per region.

In 1999 expansion of the playoff format occurred again, as eight schools per region qualified for the playoffs, creating a regional quarterfinal round.

Early in 2020, the OHSAA approved a proposal from the Ohio High School Football Coaches Association to expand to 12 teams per region.

(In 2020, the OHSAA made pandemic adjustments to the football post season, allowing all schools to participate)

In the last four seasons, the OHSAA used a format that allowed up to 16 teams in each region to qualify for the playoffs



Buchtel scored on a long touchdown pass in the second quarter.

Lake Catholic (5-2, 1-1 NCC) rushed for 159 yards in the first half and Elyria Catholic (3-4, 1-1 NCC) was unable to counter. The Cougars pulled away with 12 points in the final five minutes of the first half.

Junior running back Danny Zmorowski led the way for Lake Catholic with 96 yards and a touchdown. Sophomore quarterback Max Pisano added 89 yards and two scores.

Pisano started the night off with a 54-yard touchdown run on Lake Catholic's third play from scrimmage. The sophomore's run went for more yards than Elyria Catholic's first-half total (37).

The Cougars took the lead just 3:38 into the game and never fell behind.

Both teams traded punts before Lake Catholic's ground game got going once again. Zmorowski broke off a 33-yard run and later capped off the drive with a 1-yard score with 4:56 remaining in the half.

Following another Panthers' punt, Lake Catholic was unable to find the end zone, but a 26-yard field goal from Gavyn Fredriks extended the lead to 17 with 30 seconds left. The Cougars put a safety on the board on the ensuing kickoff to take a 19-0 halftime lead.

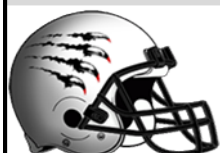

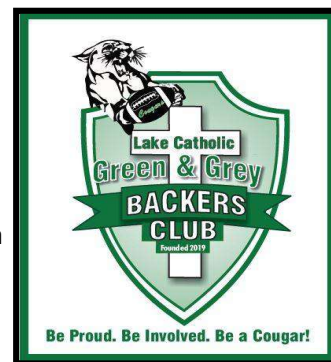
