Lake Catholic takes its No 1 state ranking on the road to face Canton Central Catholic on Oct 18.

The Crusaders are 4-4 after an 0-3 start. CCC has allowed only 62 points over the last five games after giving up 139 points in the first three. In a weird scheduling quirk, the Crusaders have played just two home games in the first 8 weeks of the season - having won them both.

The Cougars are 8-0 and all eight wins have come by 14 or more. QB Frankie Trinetti leads a dangerous offense with Ace Peterlin, Cross Nimmo, Jimmy Gibbons and D.J. Sears among his top weapons. Nathan Zappitelli anchors a very good offensive line.

Defensively, Jayson Cummings and Patrick Radigan are just two of the standouts for Lake Catholic.

Chalk Talk with QB Frankie Trinetti & TE/DE Chase Nimmo

Frankie Trinetti: "Everything starts with the guys up front. We can't be a great offense and do what we want to do without them."

"Canton Central Catholic has a lot of good players so we know we have to be ready to play."

Chase Nimmo: "We are a confident group on offense and we know with Frankie back there he is going to make the right decisions and get us the ball."

The Cougars turned back a stubborn Canton Central Catholic team, 37-20, on a perfect night for football at Jerome T. Osborne Stadium, and a big reason why they won their fifth straight game is the way they finished the first half.

Leading 17-7, the Cougars took possession on the Crusaders' 47 with 1:20 left in the second quarter. The drive stalled, and Lake had to punt.

DJ Spears scores easily from the 1 Friday night to put Cougars on top of Canton Central Catholic, 10-0. The TD was set up by a 59-yard pass play from Frankie Trinetti to Cross Nimmo.

Josh Styles barreled in from the 5 to give the Cougars a 24-7 lead at halftime.

Trinetti completed 13 of 17 passes for 259 yards in the first half. He hooked up with Cross Nimmo for 53 yards to the Crusaders' 1 and then bullish tight end DJ Sears finished off the drive to give Lake a 10-0 lead.

Lake Catholic piled up 479 yards of offense — 288 through the air and 191 on the ground. Styles rushed for 82 yards and three touchdowns on 12 carries.

THE OHSAA FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS REMAIN IN CANTON

In November, 2023, the Ohio High School Athletic Association and the Pro Football Hall of Fame announced a new three-year contract that will keep the OHSAA football state championships in Canton at Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium through 2026.

After Ohio Stadium in Columbus hosted the state championships throughout the 1980s, the finals moved to Massillon and Canton in Stark County from 1990 through 2013. The finals moved back to The Ohio State University from 2014-16, which was also when Fawcett Stadium in Canton was torn down and Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium was built. Tom Benson HOF Stadium has hosted the state finals since 2017, with the exception of 2020 due to the pandemic, when the finals were hosted in Obetz and Massillon.

Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium is a 17,000 seat NFL-caliber stadium surrounded by Hall of Fame Village, a mixed-use development project, that features shopping, entertainment, and dining options.

2024 Independent / 2025 North Coast Conf

The North Coast Conference (Lake Catholic's new athletic conference) will not begin officially sponsoring FOOTBALL until the fall of 2025.

THE BEGINNING OF THE NORTH COAST CONFERENCE

The 2024-25 school year brings the beginning of a new league consisting of religiousaffiliated schools, named the North Coast Conference. The league was formally announced in May, 2023.

The new league will include Lake Catholic, Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin, Beaumont, and Padua from the Crown Conference, Elyria Catholic and Holy Name from the Great Lakes Conference, and Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy from the Principal's Athletic

All the schools competed in their old conferences during the 2023-24 school year with North Coast Conference play beginning this fall. Football will be the only exception, as not every school will play each other since most of the 2024 schedules have already been set. Even though there will not be a football league champion in 2024, allconference honors will be awarded.

"The transition to the North Coast Conference is a great opportunity for Lake Catholic and our partner schools," said Lake Catholic Principal Tom McKrill. "Our students work very hard in the classroom every day, and this will be a great opportunity for our studentathletes to continue to compete with other faith-based schools in interscholastic athletics."



2024 - Week 8 (October 11) Rewind

NO SLOWING DOWN THE COUGARS, POST MOST POINTS IN GAME THIS YEAR

Another Friday night, another dominant performance by the No. 1 team in the state in Division IV.

After a somewhat surprising opening series on defense, Lake Catholic pounded Elyria Catholic, 49-6, on Oct. 11 at the JTO to improve to 8-0 on the season.



Elyria Catholic scored on its first play from scrimmage.

The Panthers couldn't move the ball past the 50-yard line until the fourth quarter.

Frankie Trinetti hit Ace Peterlin for a TD on the first possession and found Cross Nimmo for a 37-yard touchdown shortly after to open the Cougars' offensive onslaught.

The next drive featured a mix of run and pass, capped off by a George Csepegi 2-yard touchdown.

Trinetti finished 17-of-20 for 288 yards and three touchdowns. At one point in the first half, he connected on 12 straight passes.

Running back Jimmy Gibbons finished with 14 carries for 70 yards and a score.

Nimmo finished the game with six catches for 149 yards.

 $\ensuremath{\text{D.J.}}$ Sears punched it in from the 1-yard line for the score.

Out of the half, Ace Peterlin had an interception that set the Cougars up inside the red zone and Gibbons capped it off with a 10-yard score.

In the third with the running clock, Csepegi was handed the ball on six straight plays, capped with a 33-yard score.

Lake Catholic has its last two regular season games on the road, starting with a tilt against Canton Central Catholic on Oct. 18.

Marty Gibbons'11 enters his sixth season as the head coach of his alma mater. Gibbons was hired on November 21, 2018, and took over a program that his father, John Gibbons, led to state championships in 1991 and 1992.

As a player for the Cougars, Gibbons was a member of two state semifinal teams (2009 & 2010), earning 2nd team All-State at defensive back. In the opening game of the 2010 season, Gibbons helped the Cougars defeat the St. Ignatius Wildcats at Cleveland Browns Stadium.

Gibbons played collegiately at John Carroll University. As a player with the Blue Streaks, the team made the NCAA Division III playoffs in 2013 and 2014. The 2014 advanced to the national quarterfinal, defeating both Centre College and Wheaton College in the tournament.

Prior to accepting the head coaching job with the Cougars, Gibbons spent the 2017 season as the defensive coordinator at Villa Angela - St. Joseph.

Before his stint at VASJ, he assisted with defensive backs at Notre Dame College (2016) and also helped his brother, Mike Gibbons, at Medina Highland (2015).

Marty Gibbons is the youngest of nine children for John & Patty Gibbons. His brothers, Tom & Mike have coaching roots in Northeast Ohio, as does his brother-in-law, Tom Lombardo.



Junior Varsity Game Summary

The JV Cougars traveled to Elyria Catholic on Saturday, October 12th. Robert Allison got the Cougars defense off to a fast start on the opening possession of the game with a sack. Sophomore quarterback Charlie Spies would make sure the Cougar offense would start fast, finding Quinn Stayer on a 37 yard connection. Spies would hook up with sophomore Carter Matejka from 6 yards out to cap the Cougars opening drive. Gavyn Fredriks would nail the extra point, staking the visiting Cougars to a 7-0 lead. Following a Brady Moran sack, Mikey Barnes would block the EC punt which was scooped up and ran into the endzone by freshman Gio Magistrelli. Fredriks kick was good for a 14-0 Cougars lead. The Panthers would put a drive together in the second quarter capped by a 21 yard touchdown pass. The two point conversion failed. After a stalled Cougar drive Barnes would strip an EC ball carrier and return the ball 52 yards for the touchdown. The extra point was good by Fredriks and the Cougars led 21-6. Moran would end the next EC series with a sack and Cougars freshman quarterback Max Pisano would take over at his own 10 yard line. After long connections with Stayer (47 yards) and sophomore Joey Nagy (33 yards) Pisano would punch it in from the 1, on the ground. The extra point was good. 
Freshman Game Summary

Trinetti '25 Claims Another Record

Even as the 2024 season began, Lake Catholic senior Frankie Trinetti had already established himself as one of the best quarterbacks in the school's history, but with one more season to play he could continue to write his name in both the school's and Lake County records hooks

Trinetti already held most of the passing records at Lake Catholic, but there was one record that he was pursuing in his Cougar tenure - - career passing touchdowns.

On Aug. 30, Trinetti threw a touchdown pass of 58 yards to Ace Peterlin in the second quarter, recording his 55th career touchdown pass, tying Pete Jelovic for the school record.



Trinetti is the leader for 12 Lake Catholic passing records, including the career touchdown passes:

Frankie Trinetti (2022-pr) 72 career TD passes Pete Jelovic (1990-92) 55 career TD passes

Trinetti also has an outside chance at becoming Lake County's all-time leader in career passing yards. The Lake County record is currently held by Mentor alum and current Buffalo Bills quarterback, Mitchell Trubisky.

Trubisky threw for 9,126 yards in his high school career (ranking 20th all-time in the state of Ohio) for the Cardinals.

Trinetti has thrown for 6,905 yards (through 8 weeks of the 2024 season) and he needs 2,222 yards passing the remainder of the season to become the Lake County record holder in career passing yards.

Once Trinetti passes the 7,000 career passing yard mark, he will be one of the top 70 all time passers in the state of Ohio.

NIMMO '25 PICKS THE TWIN CITIES

Cross Nimmo'25, the 6-foot-6, 230-pound, senior tight end, announced his commitment to the University of Minnesota in April.

Nimmo, a two-way player for the Cougars, had over 800 yards receiving and 15 touchdowns in 2023, plus played defensive end for a Lake Catholic team that made the post-season for just the second time in a dozen years.

Rated three stars by the recruiting services, Nimmo picked the P.J Fleck coached Minnesota Golden Gophers over 12 other programs who offered him full-ride athletic scholarships — including two other Big 10 schools and five of the Mid American Conference teams.

JUNIOR OL PICKING UP OFFERS

Lake Catholic junior offensive lineman, Nathan Zappitelli '26, is quickly picking up scholarship offers.

The 6-foot-4, 260 pound interior lineman has collected seven (7) total offers, all prior to the start of the season.

Six MAC conference teams have expressed interest, including the winners of both divsions of MAC football last season - Miami University and the University of Toledo.




