COUGARS KICKOFF NOTES

Lake Catholic puts its 7-0 record on the line as it hosts Elyria Catholic at the JTO on Oct. 11.

The Panthers are 1-6 with the lone win over another 1-6 team in Akron St. Vincent-St. Mary. Currently, the team is out of the playoff picture in Division III, Region 10.

Darrell Schumpert and Connor Petrus are two of the top offensive weapons for EC. The Panthers have scored 28 points in two games, including the win over Akron St. Vincent-St. Mary.

The Cougars are rolling in impressive fashion, starting the year with seven straight wins for the first time since 2005.

Offensively it is an embarrassment of riches led by Frankie Trinetti at QB, D.J. Sears, Jimmy Gibbons, Ace Peterlin and Cross Nimmo among others. The team is scoring more than 35 points per game and in last week's win over Padua, nearly topped the 500-yard mark in total offense.

Defensively, Patrick Radigan, Jayson Cummings and Nick Biondolillo have all been standouts this fall.

Chalk Talk with Coach Gibbons

"We came out fine against Padua and jumped on them, but the great teams can sustain and we just had a little lull. I think our guys realize they still haven't been able to go out and dominate teams they should for a full game yet and that is just a matter of striving for something special which all thee guys want."

"I think (the No. 1 AP ranking) is a big thing for the community and the school and while we know we have a long way to go this year and work to do, we aren't going to shy away from it. I think it is a sense of pride for these guys and they have worked hard to earn it."

"I think at this point most of the teams in our region go into the game week worrying about themselves more than concerning themselves with who the opponent is. You prepare hard and respect everyone, but we have to focus on wat we do well and keep getting better."

Lake Catholic defeated Elyria Catholic, 35-12, on Friday night.

The Cougars showed no real intention to pass, and as a result, Lake Catholic ran for 315 yards. And showing utter disregard for the Panthers' high-scoring offense, the Cougars didn't allow a meaningful touchdown after the first drive of the game, issuing an emphatic North Coast League schedule going-away gift for Elyria Catholic. Coming on the heels of a Randy Greenwood touchdown run to start the game, Elyria Catholic put together a nice 13-play, 65-yard drive to cut the gap to 7-6. But that's when Lake Catholic started imposing its will.

The Cougars put together another long drive, capped by a Mike Sweigert touchdown run, held Elyria Catholic on downs, and then punched in another score, with Greenwood doing the honors from 15 yards out. Possibly in an act of desperation, Elyria Catholic went for it on fourth-and-10 on its own 42. And when the Panthers didn't make it, the Cougars tacked another one on the board when Greenwood cut around a good downfield block and scored from the 20. Though they piled up a lot of yards, the Panthers never threatened again after falling back, 21-6.

The only reason it wasn't 35-6 at the half was Greenwood's 92-yard interception return for a touchdown was called back because of a penalty. Greenwood played just the first half, but totalled 144 yards rushing on 19 carries and three touchdowns.

THE OHSAA FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS REMAIN IN CANTON

In November, 2023, the Ohio High School Athletic Association and the Pro Football Hall of Fame announced a new three-year contract that will keep the OHSAA football state championships in Canton at Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium through 2026.

After Ohio Stadium in Columbus hosted the state championships throughout the 1980s, the finals moved to Massillon and Canton in Stark County from 1990 through 2013. The finals moved back to The Ohio State University from 2014-16, which was also when Fawcett Stadium in Canton was torn down and Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium was built. Tom Benson HOF Stadium has hosted the state finals since 2017, with the exception of 2020 due to the pandemic, when the finals were hosted in Obetz and Massillon.

Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium is a 17,000 seat NFL-caliber stadium surrounded by Hall of Fame Village, a mixed-use development project, that features shopping, entertainment, and dining options.

2024 Independent / 2025 North Coast Conf

The North Coast Conference (Lake Catholic's new athletic conference) will not begin officially sponsoring FOOTBALL until the fall of 2025.

THE BEGINNING OF THE NORTH COAST CONFERENCE

The 2024-25 school year brings the beginning of a new league consisting of religiousaffiliated schools, named the North Coast Conference. The league was formally announced in May, 2023.

The new league will include Lake Catholic, Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin, Beaumont, and Padua from the Crown Conference, Elyria Catholic and Holy Name from the Great Lakes Conference, and Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy from the Principal's Athletic Conference.

All the schools competed in their old conferences during the 2023-24 school year with North Coast Conference play beginning this fall. Football will be the only exception, as not every school will play each other since most of the 2024 schedules have already been set. Even though there will not be a football league champion in 2024, all-conference honors will be awarded.

"The transition to the North Coast Conference is a great opportunity for Lake Catholic and our partner schools," said Lake Catholic Principal Tom McKrill. "Our students work very hard in the classroom every day, and this will be a great opportunity for our studentathletes to continue to compete with other faith-based schools in interscholastic athletics."

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium



Jerome I. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is the home to the Lake Catholic Cougars varsity tootball team. The facility was renovated prior to the start of the 2006 season and has been updated and enhanced prior to 2014 and 2023 seasons. The stadium is often referred to as 'The JTO'.

As part of the original renovations of the JTO, the Osborne family earmarked \$750,000 to the Mentor School District to install an artificial turf football field, a new rubberized track and a new scoreboard at the stadium.

Lake Catholic High School also donated \$300,000 to the initial project and the Cougars played the first-ever football game in the renovated stadium on Aug. 26, 2006 against the Euclid Panthers. The facility has a total capacity of 8,000.

ELYRIA CATHOLIC NEWS AND NOTES

2024 marks the 40th anniversary of Elyria Catholic's last football championship. The Panthers claimed the title in 1984 with a 45-20 win over Cincinnati McNicholas for the Division III championship.

EC completed the season a perfect 13-0 (only three rounds of OHSAA playoffs in 1984) to extend the school's unbeaten string to 26 games.

The Panthers outscored their opponents, 553-84 for the year with five shutouts.

Four Panther players were named to the All-Ohio team with Al McKinney named as Ohio's Back-of-the-Year and Geoff Povle the Lineman of the Year - unprecedented for Lorain County schools.

2024 - Week 7 (October 4) Rewind

COUGARS CONTINUE TO ROLL; ARE 7-0 FOR FIRST TIME IN 20 YEARS

The beat goes on for the Lake Catholic Cougars and so do the beatings for their opponents.

After a less-than-ideal ending to the first half. Lake Catholic dominated the final 24 minutes of play in a 46-17 win over Padua at the JTO.

The Cougars improved to 7-0 for the first time since 2005. Even their state semifinalist teams of 2009 and 2010 were only 6-1 after Week 7.

Ironically, Padua upset that 7-0 2005 Cougars team the next week, 22-21.

Senior QB Frankie Trinetti passed for 313 yards and four touchdowns, connecting with three different receivers.

The Lake Catholic defense was just as troublesome for the visitors and standout senior running back Roderick Love, who rushed for 257 yards and four touchdowns in Padua's win over North Royalton, but was limited to 37 yards rushing and 18 receiving by the Cougars' defense before leaving in the third quarter with an injury.

After a scoreless first quarter, Lake Catholic went ahead, 17-0, after a 23-yard field goal by Harley Forkins and Trinetti scoring passes of 41 yards to Patrick Radigan and 29 to Cross Nimmo.

The Bruins cut the deficit to 17-10 at halftime.

Lake Catholic scored on each of its first four possessions in the second half.

Passes of 32 and 11 yards from Trinetti to Peterlin, and runs of 36 yards by Jimmy Gibbons and 3 yards by Michael Valentino were the end results of those drives that put the game out of reach.

Marty Gibbons'11 enters his sixth season as the head coach of his alma mater. Gibbons was hired on November 21, 2018, and took over a program that his father, John Gibbons, led to state championships in 1991 and 1992.

As a player for the Cougars, Gibbons was a member of two state semifinal teams (2009 & 2010), earning 2nd team All-State at defensive back. In the opening game of the 2010 season, Gibbons helped the Cougars defeat the St. Ignatius Wildcats at Cleveland Browns Stadium.

Gibbons played collegiately at John Carroll University. As a player with the Blue Streaks, the team made the NCAA Division III playoffs in 2013 and 2014. The 2014 advanced to the national quarterfinal, defeating both Centre College and Wheaton College in the tournament.

Prior to accepting the head coaching job with the Cougars, Gibbons spent the 2017 season as the defensive coordinator at Villa Angela – St. Joseph.

Before his stint at VASJ, he assisted with defensive backs at Notre Dame College (2016) and also helped his brother, Mike Gibbons, at Medina Highland (2015).

Marty Gibbons is the youngest of nine children for John & Patty Gibbons. His brothers, Tom & Mike have coaching roots in Northeast Ohio, as does his brother-in-law, Tom Lombardo.

Trinetti '25 Claims Another Record

Even as the 2024 season began, Lake Catholic senior Frankie Trinetti had already established himself as one of the best quarterbacks in the school's history, but with one more season to play he could continue to write his name in both the school's and Lake County records books.

Trinetti already held most of the passing records at Lake Catholic, but there was one record that he was pursuing in his Cougar tenure - - career passing touchdowns.

On Aug. 30, Trinetti threw a touchdown pass of 58 yards to Ace Peterlin in the second quarter, recording his 55th career touchdown pass, tying Pete Jelovic for the school record.

In the second quarter, Trinetti again connected with Ace Peterlin on a long touchdown pass – this time 71 yards. This was Trinetti's 56th career touchdown pass, passing Jelovic to become the all-time leader at Lake Catholic.

Trinetti is the leader for 12 Lake Catholic passing records, including the career touchdown passes:

Frankie Trinetti (2022-pr)69 career TD passesPete Jelovic (1990-92)55 career TD passes

Trinetti also has an outside chance at becoming Lake County's all-time leader in career passing yards. The Lake County record is currently held by Mentor alum and current Buffalo Bills quarterback, Mitchell Trubisky.

Trubisky threw for 9,126 yards in his high school career (ranking 20th all-time in the state of Ohio) for the Cardinals.

Trinetti has thrown for 6,629 yards (through 7 weeks of the 2024 season) and he needs 2,497 yards passing the remainder of the season to become the Lake County record holder in career passing yards.

Once Trinetti passes the 7,000 career passing yard mark, he will be one of the top 70 all time passers in the state of Ohio.

NIMMO '25 PICKS THE TWIN CITIES

Cross Nimmo'25, the 6-foot-6, 230-pound, senior tight end, announced his commitment to the University of Minnesota in April.

Nimmo, a two-way player for the Cougars, had over 800 yards receiving and 15 touchdowns in 2023, plus played defensive end for a Lake Catholic team that made the post-season for just the second time in a dozen years.

Rated three stars by the recruiting services, Nimmo picked the P.J Fleck coached Minnesota Golden Gophers over 12 other programs who offered him full-ride athletic scholarships — including two other Big 10 schools and five of the Mid American Conference teams.

Lake Catholic junior offensive lineman, Nathan Zappitelli '26, is quickly picking up scholarship offers.

The 6-foot-4, 260 pound interior lineman has collected seven (7) total offers, all prior to the start of the season.

Six MAC conference teams have expressed interest, including the winners of both divsions of MAC football last season - Miami University and the University of Toledo.


