### **COUGARS KICKOFF NOTES**

Lake Catholic will put its 11-0 record and top seed on the line in a Division IV second-round playoff game against Mogadore Field on Nov. 8.

The Falcons are 9-2 and have allowed more than 20 points only twice in 11 games - both coming their losses. Field running back Drexal McAmis is 6-foot-3, 250 pounds and a load for defenses to deal with.

The Cougars continue to be balanced and dangerous in all phases of the game. Offensively, senior QB Frankie Trinetti is having an All-Ohio campaign, setting school records and utilizing weapons like Jimmy Gibbons, Patrick Radigan, D.J. Sears, Ace Peterlin and Cross Nimmo. Nathan Zappitelli is a Division I recruit and anchor on the offensive line.

Defensively, Jayson Cummings, Marty Loncar and Nick Biondolillo are just a few of many playmakers for Lake Catholic.

The winner will play either Beloit West Branch or Glenville on Nov. 15 in the Region 13 semifinals

Lake Catholic is moving on to the second round of the Division IV, Region 13 playoffs, and this time there was more to the story than the Cougars' electrifying offense led by quarterback Frankie Trinetti

The Cougars knocked out the pesky Mogadore Field Falcons, 38-14, on a windy Oct. 27 at North's Nick Carter Field.

Lake improved to 9-2 and Nov. 3 will face Niles McKinley in the second round.

Lake Catholic entered the playoff as the second seed and Field as the 15th seed.

The Cougars were protecting a 17-7 lead when the Falcons were knocking on the door late in the second quarter.

Falcons quarterback L.J. Riley took the snap when everything was set and fired a pass toward the end zone in the middle of the field.

Lake Catholic defensive back Caden Boyes intercepted Riley's pass, and the rest of the night belonged to the Cougars.

Lake Catholic got on the board first when DJ Sears ran into the end zone from the 2 with 6:13 left in the first quarter.

The next drive stalled, but sure-footed junior kicker Harley Forkins nailed a 34-yard field goal for a 10-0 lead.

Lake took the third-quarter kickoff and struck quickly. Junior tight end Cross Nimmo got behind the Field defense and Trinetti hit him in stride for a 49-yard catch-and-run for a touchdown with 10:35 left in the third quarter.

The defense forced a punt, and Lake struck quickly again when Josh Styles broke loose on a 50-yard touchdown gallop to expand the Lake Catholic lead to 31-7.

Sophomore quarterback Luke Anzlovar found Nimmo in the back of the end zone for a seven-yard touchdown pass with 5:23 remaining in the fourth quarter to finish off the Lake Catholic scoring.

### THE BEGINNING OF THE NORTH COAST CONFERENCE

The 2024-25 school year brings the beginning of a new league consisting of religiousaffiliated schools, named the North Coast Conference. The league was formally announced in May, 2023.

The new league will include Lake Catholic, Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin, Beaumont, and Padua from the Crown Conference, Elyria Catholic and Holy Name from the Great Lakes Conference, and Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy from the Principal's Athletic

All the schools competed in their old conferences during the 2023-24 school year with North Coast Conference play beginning this fall. Football will be the only exception, as not every school will play each other since most of the 2024 schedules have already been set. Even though there will not be a football league champion in 2024, allconference honors will be awarded.

"The transition to the North Coast Conference is a great opportunity for Lake Catholic and our partner schools," said Lake Catholic Principal Tom McKrill. "Our students work very hard in the classroom every day, and this will be a great opportunity for our studentathletes to continue to compete with other faith-based schools in interscholastic athletics."

### Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium



Jerome I. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is the home to the Lake Catholic Cougars varsity tootball team. The facility was renovated prior to the start of the 2006 season and has been updated and enhanced prior to 2014 and 2023 seasons. The stadium is often referred to as 'The JTO'.

As part of the original renovations of the JTO, the Osborne family earmarked \$750,000 to the Mentor School District to install an artificial turf football field, a new rubberized track and a new scoreboard at the stadium.

Lake Catholic High School also donated \$300,000 to the initial project and the Cougars played the first-ever football game in the renovated stadium on Aug. 26, 2006 against the Euclid Panthers. The facility has a total capacity of 8.000.

The Mogadore Field Falcons won the school's first ever OHSAA playoff game last week, with a 24-16 victory over Lutheran East.

Prior to the win last week, the Field Falcons were 0-8, making appearances in 2023, 2022, 2020, 2014, 2010, 2009, 2008, and 2007.

### 2024 - Week 11 (November 1 - Reg 13, 1st Rd) Rewind

2024 Football Game Notes

A change of home venue, but the same old dominance for top-seeded Lake Catholic in its playoff opener.

The Cougars scored 35 points after the first quarter and rolled past the 16th-seeded Ravenna Ravens, 42-14, at North's Nick Carter Stadium in Eastlake on Nov. 1.

Lake Catholic was unable to play at the JTO as usual for home games as Mentor was hosting St. Ignatius.

The Cougars are 11-0. Ravenna's season ends at 4-7.

Lake Catholic got touchdowns from six players and played dominant defense from beginning to end. The Cougars meet Mogadore Field in a second-round playoff game Nov. 8 at a site to be determined.

Lake Catholic kicked off and on Ravenna's first play from scrimmage, the Cougars forced a fumble. Jimmy Gibbons recovered the ball and the Cougars wasted no time in turning the takeaway into an 8-yard touchdown pass from Frankie Trinetti to senior wide receiver Patrick Radigan.

Two second-quarter Lake Catholic touchdowns, one on a running play and one a pass by Trinetti, were wiped out by holding penalties, but even with those mistakes the Cougars made enough big plays to take a 21-0 lead into the locker room at halftime.

Lake senior defensive lineman Jack Gagala caught a deflection of a pass by Cross Nimmo at the Ravenna 10 and ran to the end zone for a 14-0 lead with 10 minutes left in the second quarter.

A 7-vard touchdown pass from Trinetti to Nimmo with 23 seconds left in the half increased the lead to 21-0.

Nick Biondolillo fielded the second-half kickoff at the Lake 20 and, with the help of solid blocking, raced to the end zone for a 28-0 lead.

Caden Boyes, Lake's leading rusher with 80 yards on 16 carries, scored on a 4-yard touchdown run in the third quarter. Trinetti hit DJ Sears on a 25-yard scoring pass in the fourth quarter for Lake Catholic's sixth and final touchdown.







Marty Gibbons'11 enters his sixth season as the head coach of his alma mater. Gibbons was hired on November 21, 2018, and took over a program that his father, John Gibbons, led to state championships in 1991 and 1992.

As a player for the Cougars, Gibbons was a member of two state semifinal teams (2009 & 2010), earning 2nd team All-State at defensive back. In the opening game of the 2010 season, Gibbons helped the Cougars defeat the St. Ignatius Wildcats at Cleveland Browns Stadium.

Gibbons played collegiately at John Carroll University. As a player with the Blue Streaks, the team made the NCAA Division III playoffs in 2013 and 2014. The 2014 advanced to the national quarterfinal, defeating both Centre College and Wheaton College in the tournament.

Prior to accepting the head coaching job with the Cougars, Gibbons spent the 2017 season as the defensive coordinator at Villa Angela - St. Joseph.

Before his stint at VASJ, he assisted with defensive backs at Notre Dame College (2016) and also helped his brother, Mike Gibbons, at Medina Highland (2015).

Marty Gibbons is the youngest of nine children for John & Patty Gibbons. His brothers, Tom & Mike have coaching roots in Northeast Ohio, as does his brother-in-law, Tom Lombardo.

### Trinetti '25 Claims Another Record

Even as the 2024 season began, Lake Catholic senior Frankie Trinetti had already established himself as one of the best quarterbacks in the school's history, but with one more season to play he could continue to write his name in both the school's and Lake County records hooks

Trinetti already held most of the passing records at Lake Catholic, but there was one record that he was pursuing in his Cougar tenure - - career passing touchdowns.

On Aug. 30, Trinetti threw a touchdown pass of 58 yards to Ace Peterlin in the second quarter, recording his 55th career touchdown pass, tying Pete Jelovic for the school record



In the second quarter, Trinetti again connected with Ace Peterlin on a long touchdown pass – this time 71 yards. This was Trinetti's 56th career touchdown pass, passing Jelovic to become the all-time leader at Lake Catholic.

Trinetti is the leader for 12 Lake Catholic passing records, including the career touchdown passes:

Frankie Trinetti (2022-pr) **78 career TD passes** Pete Jelovic (1990-92) **55** career TD passes

Trinetti also has an outside chance at becoming Lake County's all-time leader in career passing yards. The Lake County record is currently held by Mentor alum and current Buffalo Bills quarterback, Mitchell Trubisky.

Trubisky threw for 9,126 yards in his high school career (ranking 20th all-time in the state of Ohio) for the Cardinals.

Trinetti has thrown for 7,644 yards (through 11 weeks of the 2024 season) and he needs 1,482 yards passing the remainder of the season to become the Lake County record holder in career passing yards.

Trinetti's 7,644 career passing yards puts him at 54th on the Ohio HS Athletic Association list of all time passers.




