COUGARS KICKOFF NOTES

In a matchup many people have been waiting for since prior to the season started in August, two of the top teams will face off as Lake Catholic and Glenville meet with a chance at a spot in the Division IV, Region 13 finals.

The Tarblooders have three losses to teams that are a combined 32-4 and have a win over Division I powerhouse St. Edward.

LaMarques Greenwood has taken over at QB as a sophomore with plenty of talent around him, including Chris Newell and Pauly Sadler. The offensive line has multiple college prospects.

Defensively, Cincere Johnson leads the way at middle linebacker for Glenville.

Lake Catholic has proven to be a well-rounded, balanced team that can beat teams in a variety of different ways.

Offensively, the Cougars are led by QB Frankie Trinetti with plenty of weapons at his disposal. Ace Peterlin is closing in on a school record for catches, D.J. Sears, Jimmy Gibbons and Cross Nimmo are among many weapons on offense. The offensive line led by D-I recruit Nathan Zappitelli is a wall at tackle for Lake Catholic.

Defensively, Patrick Radigan can do it all, including special teams and Jayson Cummings, Marty Loncar and Ray Troha are among several standouts.

It took four tries, but the Lake Catholic Cougars secured a game for Sept. 10, 'settling' for a game against the Glenville Tarblooders played at Jerome T Osborne Stadium.

The Tarblooders were the fourth opponent the Cougars had on the schedule for the Week 4 of the 2021 season. Games against Norton, Walnut Ridge, and University School were all cancelled due to Covid protocols for each of those opponents. Glenville had an opening on their schedule when John Marshall was unable to meet the requirements of the Cleveland Metropolitan School District's policies for sports participation with Covid restrictions.

The teams agreed to the game on Thursday afternoon.

Glenville unveiled a blanketing defense and threw it all over Lake Catholic in a 34-0 shutout. The Cougars tallied less than 100 yards in total offense including just 5 yards rushing against the aggressive Tarblooders defense. Lake Catholic managed just 6 first downs in the game.

On the other side, the Tarblooders pounded the ball offensively, tallying almost 250 yards rushing against the exhausted Cougars defense. Glenville had 283 yards in total offense.

The Tarblooders led 14-0 at halftime, but scored two touchdowns in the third quarter to blow the game open.

With the loss, the Cougars fell to 1-3 on the season, while Glenville earned the team's first win of the season after opening with consecutive losses to Chardon, Olentangy Liberty and Avon.

THE BEGINNING OF THE NORTH COAST CONFERENCE

The 2024-25 school year brings the beginning of a new league consisting of religious-affiliated schools, named the North Coast Conference. The league was formally announced in May, 2023.

The new league will include Lake Catholic, Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin, Beaumont, and Padua from the Crown Conference, Elyria Catholic and Holy Name from the Great Lakes Conference, and Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy from the Principal's Athletic Conference.

All the schools competed in their old conferences during the 2023-24 school year with North Coast Conference play beginning this fall. Football will be the only exception, as not every school will play each other since most of the 2024 schedules have already been set. Even though there will not be a football league champion in 2024, all-conference honors will be awarded.

"The transition to the North Coast Conference is a great opportunity for Lake Catholic and our partner schools," said Lake Catholic Principal Tom McKrill. "Our students work very hard in the classroom every day, and this will be a great opportunity for our student-athletes to continue to compete with other faith-based schools in interscholastic athletics."

Again, the Lake Catholic Football Program, thanks Mr. Ted Rieple for his donation. Ted's wife Shelly (Kilroy) Rieple is a 1990 graduate of Lake Catholic. Their children, Nicholas '17, Nathan '19 and Kennedy '21 are all graduates, as well. Mr. Rieple is Frankie Trinetti '24 and Ace Peterlins '24 uncle.

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is the home to the Lake Catholic Cougars varsity football team. The facility was renovated prior to the start of the 2006 season and has been updated and enhanced prior to 2014 and 2023 seasons. The stadium is often referred to as 'The JTO'.

As part of the original renovations of the JTO, the Osborne family earmarked \$750,000 to the Mentor School District to install an artificial turf football field, a new rubberized track and a new scoreboard at the stadium.

Lake Catholic High School also donated \$300,000 to the initial project and the Cougars played the first-ever football game in the renovated stadium on Aug. 26, 2006 against the Euclid Panthers. The facility has a total capacity of 8,000.

GLENVILLE TARBLOODERS - DID YOU KNOW

In the past five seasons (excluding 2020 because Glenville did not field team), the Tarblooders have played 28 Senate games, giving up just 58 points in those 28 games, including 20 shutouts.

2024 - Week 12 (November 8 - Reg 13, 1st Rd) Rewind

Playing in its third different "home" stadium of the year in a second-round playoff matchup with Mogadore Field, Lake Catholic continued to be unfriendly hosts to whoever visits the Cougars.

Patrick Radigan had a big performance in all phases, Frankie Trinetti threw for 183 yards and three TDs, Nick Biondolillo contributed two interceptions and Lake Catholic routed the Falcons, 35-3, at Riverside High School in Painesville Township on Nov. 8.

The Cougars (12-0) will take on Glenville, a 13-0 winner over West Branch, in a D-IV, Region 13 semifinal Nov. 15 at a site to be determined.

Trinetti found Tyler Hribar a little less than midway through the opening quarter for an 11-yard TD to open the scoring.

Biondolillo had his first interception on Field's opening possession, giving Lake Catholic a short field at the Falcons' 25.

Three plays later, Trinetti connected with Radigan for a 25-yard TD and a 14-0 lead.

In the second, the Cougars had their lone punt of the evening, but Radigan backed the Falcons up to their own 3 with the kick.

Lake Catholic forced a punt. A 28-yard Trinetti-to-Radigan connection got it down to the Field 1, and George Csepegi finished off the drive with the TD.

Trinetti found Caden Boyes wide-open down the sideline for a 30-yard score and a 28-0 advantage.

Jimmy Gibbons (nine carries, 46 yards) capped off a two-play march with a seven-yard TD and the final margin at 35-3 as a running clock came into play.

Marty Gibbons'11 enters his sixth season as the head coach of his alma mater. Gibbons was hired on November 21, 2018, and took over a program that his father, John Gibbons, led to state championships in 1991 and 1992.

As a player for the Cougars, Gibbons was a member of two state semifinal teams (2009 & 2010), earning 2nd team All-State at defensive back. In the opening game of the 2010 season, Gibbons helped the Cougars defeat the St. Ignatius Wildcats at Cleveland Browns Stadium.

Gibbons played collegiately at John Carroll University. As a player with the Blue Streaks, the team made the NCAA Division III playoffs in 2013 and 2014. The 2014 advanced to the national quarterfinal, defeating both Centre College and Wheaton College in the tournament.

Prior to accepting the head coaching job with the Cougars, Gibbons spent the 2017 season as the defensive coordinator at Villa Angela – St. Joseph.

Before his stint at VASJ, he assisted with defensive backs at Notre Dame College (2016) and also helped his brother, Mike Gibbons, at Medina Highland (2015).

Marty Gibbons is the youngest of nine children for John & Patty Gibbons. His brothers, Tom & Mike have coaching roots in Northeast Ohio, as does his brother-in-law, Tom Lombardo.

Trinetti '25 Claims Another Record

Even as the 2024 season began, Lake Catholic senior Frankie Trinetti had already established himself as one of the best quarterbacks in the school's history, but with one more season to play he could continue to write his name in both the school's and Lake County records books.

Trinetti already held most of the passing records at Lake Catholic, but there was one record that he was pursuing in his Cougar tenure -- career passing touchdowns.

On Aug. 30, Trinetti threw a touchdown pass of 58 yards to Ace Peterlin in the second quarter, recording his 55th career touchdown pass, tying Pete Jelovic for the school record.

In the second quarter, Trinetti again connected with Ace Peterlin on a long touchdown pass -- this time 71 yards. This was Trinetti's 56th career touchdown pass, passing Jelovic to become the all-time leader at Lake Catholic.

Trinetti is the leader for 12 Lake Catholic passing records, including the career touchdown passes:

Frankie Trinetti (2022-pr) **81 career TD passes**
Pete Jelovic (1990-92) **55 career TD passes**

Trinetti also has an outside chance at becoming Lake County's all-time leader in career passing yards. The Lake County record is currently held by Mentor alum and current Buffalo Bills quarterback, Mitchell Trubisky.

Trubisky threw for 9,126 yards in his high school career (ranking 20th all-time in the state of Ohio) for the Cardinals.

Trinetti has thrown for 7,833 yards (through 12 weeks of the 2024 season) and he needs 1,294 yards passing the remainder of the season to become the Lake County record holder in career passing yards.

Trinetti's 7,833 career passing yards puts him at 50th on the Ohio HS Athletic Association list of all time passers.
