Lake Catholic takes its 5-0 record on the road to Serpentini Stadium in North Royalton to face Holy Name on Sept. 26.

The Green Wave are 2-2 and coming off an open week. Holy Name has scored 70 points and given up 74 on the season.

The Cougars got into a second-half battle with Kenston, but pulled away for a 34-20 win in Week 6. D.J. Sears was a wrecking ball on the ground making several key plays. QB Frankie Trinetti continues his stellar career under center while Cross Nimmo and Ace Peterin are playmakers. Patrick Radigan is coming off a player of the week performance vs. the Bombers.

Lake Catholic racked up 482 yards of offense in a 39-20 victory over visiting Holy Name. But it was the balance achieved by the Cougars — 245 yards rushing and 237 passing — that portends well for the rest of the season.

Junior QB Frankie Trinetti passed for 237 yards and four touchdowns, senior running back Josh Styles hammered out 187 yards and a touchdown on 28 carries, and junior wide receiver Ace Peterlin scored three times — twice through the air and once on the ground, and finished with seven catches for 112 yards. 6-foot-5, 220-pound junior Cross Nimmo, with FBS college scouts in attendance, caught three passes, two for touchdowns.

THE OHSAA FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS REMAIN IN CANTON

In November, 2023, the Ohio High School Athletic Association and the Pro Football Hall of Fame announced a new three-year contract that will keep the OHSAA football state championships in Canton at Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium through 2026.

After Ohio Stadium in Columbus hosted the state championships throughout the 1980s, the finals moved to Massillon and Canton in Stark County from 1990 through 2013. The finals moved back to The Ohio State University from 2014-16, which was also when Fawcett Stadium in Canton was torn down and Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium was built. Tom Benson HOF Stadium has hosted the state finals since 2017, with the exception of 2020 due to the pandemic, when the finals were hosted in Obetz and Massillon.

Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium is a 17,000 seat NFL-caliber stadium surrounded by Hall of Fame Village, a mixed-use development project, that features shopping, entertainment, and dining options.

2024 Independent / 2025 North Coast Conf

The North Coast Conference (Lake Catholic's new athletic conference) will not begin officially sponsoring FOOTBALL until the fall of 2025.

THE BEGINNING OF THE NORTH COAST CONFERENCE

The 2024-25 school year brings the beginning of a new league consisting of religious-affiliated schools, named the North Coast Conference. The league was formally announced in May, 2023.

The new league will include Lake Catholic, Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin, Beaumont, and Padua from the Crown Conference, Elyria Catholic and Holy Name from the Great Lakes Conference, and Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy from the Principal's Athletic Conference.

All the schools competed in their old conferences during the 2023-24 school year with North Coast Conference play beginning this fall. Football will be the only exception, as not every school will play each other since most of the 2024 schedules have already been set. Even though there will not be a football league champion in 2024, all-conference honors will be awarded.

"The transition to the North Coast Conference is a great opportunity for Lake Catholic and our partner schools," said Lake Catholic Principal Tom McKrill. "Our students work very hard in the classroom every day, and this will be a great opportunity for our student-athletes to continue to compete with other faith-based schools in interscholastic athletics."

MEDIA POLICY

The press box at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is located atop the east side (home side) bleachers. Separate coaches' boxes are available for team personnel only. Media who need working space in the press box should request it through Erik Schroeder or Lea Crowley. Seating will be limited in the press box. For featured games, media members will be assigned seats in the press seating area and seating assignments will be posted throulgout the press box.

FIELD MEDIA POLICY

Due to limited space in the press box at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium, approved media and photographers will be permitted on the sidelines and are expected to honor all sideline policies. Media members and photographers are not allowed in the team bench areas, locker rooms, or other restricted areas in the stadium

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Credentials for photographers will be issued to those representing newspapers, bona fide publications, and other periodicals by Erik Schroeder or Lea Crowley. Please make requests in advance. All photographers are expected to honor all sideline policies and are not permitted in the team bench areas, locker rooms, or other restricted areas within Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium without prior, written authorization from the Lake Catholic Athletic Department.

MEDIA WILL CALL

Approved media or photo credentials can be obtained at the Media Will Call window located at the northwest ticket gate of Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium. The Media Will Call window opens approximately 90 minutes before the game.

LOCKER ROOM POLICY

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is the home to the Lake Catholic Cougars varsity football team. The facility was renovated prior to the start of the 2006 season and has been updated and enhanced prior to 2014 and 2023 seasons. The stadium is often referred to as 'The JTO'.



As part of the original renovations of the JTO, the Osborne family earmarked \$750,000 to the Mentor School District to install an artificial turf football field, a new rubberized track and a new scoreboard at the stadium.

Lake Catholic High School also donated \$300,000 to the initial project and the Cougars played the firstever football game in the renovated stadium on Aug. 26, 2006 against the Euclid Panthers. The facility has a total capacity of 8,000.



2024 - Week 5 (Sept. 19) Rewind

LAKE CATHOLIC REACHES HALF WAY POINT PERFECT ON THE SEASON

For the first time since Week 1, Lake Catholic faced a stiff test on Sept. 20 as Kenston visited the JTO.

But like the first four games of the season, the Cougars walked off the field winners in Week 5 after a hard-fought 34-20 win. Lake Catholic improved to 5-0.



D. J. Sears only carried five times against Kenston, but made the most of the carries. He scored three touchdowns and picked up a critical fourth down to help his team move the chains and get the game-clinching score.

Lake Catholic looked as if it was going to roll to another easy victory when the Cougars had the ball late in the third quarter with a 24-10 lead. But Kenston's Sam Meeks picked off a Frankie Trinetti screen pass and returned it deep into Cougars' territory going into the fourth quarter.

Lucas Kaltenbach ran for a 3-yard touchdown run early in the fourth to pull the Bombers within a score at 24-17. But Lake Catholic responded with a 25-yard field goal by Harley Forkins — his third field goal of the game — for a 27-17 lead. Forkins scored three goals earlier in the day in Lake's win over AOA in a boys soccer game.

After Forkins' third field goal made it a 10-point game, Kenston's Grady Kucharson kicked his second field goal of the game — a 29-yarder — with 4:45 left in the game to pull the score within seven again at 27-20.

Shortly thereafter, Sears clinched things with two key runs.

Both teams came into the game with injury concerns. Lake Catholic two-way lineman David lannini tore his ACL in last week's win over South, and running back Caden Boyes also sat out with a knee injury. Kenston's leading running back, Cohen Clark, sat out with a back injury.

Lake led, 17-3, at the half thanks to two Sears touchdown runs and a Forkins field goal. But Kenston came out of the halftime locker room with a vengeance and scored on a long drive, with freshman Ethan Burge scoring from the

The momentum in the 17-10 game swung back to Lake when Trinetti hit Ace Peterlin on a screen that went 25 yards to the end zone for the 24-10 lead.

Marty Gibbons'11 enters his sixth season as the head coach of his alma mater. Gibbons was hired on November 21, 2018, and took over a program that his father, John Gibbons, led to state championships in 1991 and 1992.

As a player for the Cougars, Gibbons was a member of two state semifinal teams (2009 & 2010), earning 2nd team All-State at defensive back. In the opening game of the 2010 season, Gibbons helped the Cougars defeat the St. Ignatius Wildcats at Cleveland Browns Stadium.

Gibbons played collegiately at John Carroll University. As a player with the Blue Streaks, the team made the NCAA Division III playoffs in 2013 and 2014. The 2014 advanced to the national quarterfinal, defeating both Centre College and Wheaton College in the tournament.


The Cougar defense would buckle down and stop the Eagles on the potential game winning drive. The game would end in a 14-14 tie!

Trinetti '25 Claims Another Record

Even as the 2024 season began, Lake Catholic senior Frankie Trinetti had already established himself as one of the best quarterbacks in the school's history, but with one more season to play he could continue to write his name in both the school's and Lake County records hooks

Trinetti already held most of the passing records at Lake Catholic, but there was one record that he was pursuing in his Cougar tenure - - career passing touchdowns.

On Aug. 30, Trinetti threw a touchdown pass of 58 yards to Ace Peterlin in the second quarter, recording his 55th career touchdown pass, tying Pete Jelovic for the school record



pass, passing Jelovic to become the all-time leader at Lake Catholic.

Trinetti is the leader for 12 Lake Catholic passing records, including the career touchdown passes:

Frankie Trinetti (2022-pr) **62** career TD passes Pete Jelovic (1990-92) **55** career TD passes

Trinetti also has an outside chance at becoming Lake County's all-time leader in career passing yards. The Lake County record is currently held by Mentor alum and current Buffalo Bills quarterback, Mitchell Trubisky.

Trubisky threw for 9,126 yards in his high school career (ranking 20th all-time in the state of Ohio) for the Cardinals.

Trinetti has thrown for 6,040 yards (through 5 weeks of the 2024 season) and he needs 3,087 yards passing the remainder of the season to become the Lake County record holder in career passing yards.

Once Trinetti passes the 7,000 career passing yard mark, he will be one of the top 70 all time in the state of Ohio.


