COUGARS KICKOFF NOTES

It's a short week and a talented opponent for Lake Catholic as the undefeated Cougars host Kenston on Sept. 19.

The Bombers are coming off a 53-35 loss to powerhouse VASJ in Week 4 to fall to 2-2 on the season.

Kenston had won two in a row since a season-opening loss to Boardman. In their most recent win, the Bombers gave up only 90 yards to Chagrin Falls — 89 rushing and one passing. Cohen Clark ran for 97 yards, and Lucas Kaltenbach threw for 89. Tymir Cardona scored on a kickoff return, punt return and on a 33-yard reception for Kenston.

Lake Catholic posted its third shutout of the season in a 47-0 win over South. The Cougars continue to be very balanced offensively behind QB Frankie Trinetti and a plethora of weapons, including D.J. Sears, Ace Peterlin, Cross Nimmo and Jimmy Gibbons.

The defesne has been simply dominant and special teams has been a weapon as well.

The Cougars will travel to Holy Name (Serpentini Chevrolet Stadium, North Royalton HS) for its first road game since Week 2 on Sept. 26.

Some coaches might shy away from labeling a midseason non-conference game as a statement game with extra emphasis. Lake Catholic football coach Marty Gibbons isn't one of those guys.

Not only did Gibbons tell his team a day before it was going to play Kenston that it was a statement game, but he shut off the scouting film long enough to tell quarterback Frankie Trinetti the Cougars were going to win 24 hours later.

The Cougars backed up their coach's belief by shellacking the host Bombers, 49-14, on Sept. 14 in a game that left most everyone leaving Bomber Stadium with their jaws wide open in disbelief.

Trinetti completed 14 of 18 passes for 302 yards and four touchdowns, D.J. Sears caught three touchdown passes and ran in another, and the Lake Catholic defense did what pretty much no one has done in recent memory — shut down Kenston's All-Ohio running back Sean Patrick.

Lake (4-1) led, 35-7, at the half, turned the game into a running clock situation with Josh Styles' 76-yard run to start the third quarter and rendered the final 23 minutes of clock time nothing more than a formality.

It was a 14-0 game, thanks to a long touchdown pass from Trinetti to Cross Nimmo, before Kenston got on the board with a short touchdown run from Patrick to make it 14-7.

But Lake Catholic scored 35 straight points before Kenston scored again.



THE OHSAA FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS REMAIN IN CANTON

In November, 2023, the Ohio High School Athletic Association and the Pro Football Hall of Fame announced a new three-year contract that will keep the OHSAA football state championships in Canton at Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium through 2026.

After Ohio Stadium in Columbus hosted the state championships throughout the 1980s, the finals moved to Massillon and Canton in Stark County from 1990 through 2013. The finals moved back to The Ohio State University from 2014-16, which was also when Fawcett Stadium in Canton was torn down and Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium was built. Tom Benson HOF Stadium has hosted the state finals since 2017, with the exception of 2020 due to the pandemic, when the finals were hosted in Obetz and Massillon.

Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium is a 17,000 seat NFL-caliber stadium surrounded by Hall of Fame Village, a mixed-use development project, that features shopping, entertainment, and dining options.

2024 Independent / 2025 North Coast Conf

The North Coast Conference (Lake Catholic's new athletic conference) will not begin officially sponsoring FOOTBALL until the fall of 2025.

Below are the other five schools that will make up the future NCC, with tracking and comparison information on all six teams.

THE BEGINNING OF THE NORTH COAST CONFERENCE

The 2024-25 school year brings the beginning of a new league consisting of religious-affiliated schools, named the North Coast Conference. The league was formally announced in May, 2023.

The new league will include Lake Catholic, Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin, Beaumont, and Padua from the Crown Conference, Elyria Catholic and Holy Name from the Great Lakes Conference, and Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy from the Principal's Athletic Conference.

All the schools competed in their old conferences during the 2023-24 school year with North Coast Conference play beginning this fall. Football will be the only exception, as not every school will play each other since most of the 2024 schedules have already been set. Even though there will not be a football league champion in 2024, all-conference honors will be awarded.

"The transition to the North Coast Conference is a great opportunity for Lake Catholic and our partner schools," said Lake Catholic Principal Tom McKrill. "Our students work very hard in the classroom every day, and this will be a great opportunity for our student-athletes to continue to compete with other faith-based schools in interscholastic athletics."

MEDIA POLICY

The press box at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is located atop the east side (home side) bleachers. Separate coaches' boxes are available for team personnel only. Media who need working space in the press box should request it through Erik Schroeder or Lea Crowley. Seating will be limited in the press box. For featured games, media members will be assigned seats in the press seating area and seating assignments will be posted throulgout the press box.

FIELD MEDIA POLICY

Due to limited space in the press box at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium, approved media and photographers will be permitted on the sidelines and are expected to honor all sideline policies. Media members and photographers are not allowed in the team bench areas, locker rooms, or other restricted areas in the stadium.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Credentials for photographers will be issued to those representing newspapers, bona fide publications, and other periodicals by Erik Schroeder or Lea Crowley. Please make requests in advance. All photographers are expected to honor all sideline policies and are not permitted in the team bench areas, locker rooms, or other restricted areas within Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium without prior, written authorization from the Lake Catholic Athletic Department.

MEDIA WILL CALL

Approved media or photo credentials can be obtained at the Media Will Call window located at the northwest ticket gate of Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium. The Media Will Call window opens approximately 90 minutes before the game.

LOCKER ROOM POLICY

Lake Catholic High School maintains a closed locker room policy for media at both Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium and on the Lake Catholic High School campus.

WEEKLY GAME NOTES

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is the home to the Lake Catholic Cougars varsity football team. The facility was renovated prior to the start of the 2006 season and has been updated and enhanced prior to 2014 and 2023 seasons. The stadium is often referred to as 'The JTO'.



As part of the original renovations of the JTO, the Osborne family earmarked \$750,000 to the Mentor School District to install an artificial turf football field, a new rubberized track and a new scoreboard at the stadium.

Lake Catholic High School also donated \$300,000 to the initial project and the Cougars played the firstever football game in the renovated stadium on Aug. 26, 2006 against the Euclid Panthers. The facility has a total capacity of 8,000.

The Cougars built an insurmountable 40-0 lead on six first-half touchdowns, setting up a running clock for the entire second half, and cruised to a 47-0

victory to improve to 4-0 over South on Sept. 13.

It was the third shutout of the season for Lake Catholic and the only 7 points allowed were late in a blowout win over CVCA in Week 2.

DJ Sears opened the scoring on a 62-yard catch and run on a pass from Frankie Trinetti on the second play of the game. The PAT failed, then Sears scored on an 12-yard pass from Trinetti for a 13-point Lake Catholic lead.

Caden Boyes made it 20-0 with 5:43 left in the first quarter by taking advantage of a fumble recovery by Ray Troha.

Jimmy Gibbons scored on a 31-yard run and on a screen pass covering 13 yards.

Sears capped off his three touchdown night on a three-yard touchdown run after Nick Biondolillo intercepted a pass to set up the Cougars on first-and-goal.

The Lake Catholic backups played the second half. After a scoreless third quarter, George Csepegi opened the fourth quarter on a 1-yard run. Harley Forkins added the PAT to build the Cougar lead and end the scoring at 47-0.

<u>NOTE</u>: Cougars senior quarterback, Frankie Trinetti, completed all 10 of his passes in the game against South, for a completion percentage of 100% The 100% sets a single game record for completion percetage for a quarterback attempting at least 10 passes.

Marty Gibbons'11 enters his sixth season as the head coach of his alma mater. Gibbons was hired on November 21, 2018, and took over a program that his father, John Gibbons, led to state championships in 1991 and 1992.

As a player for the Cougars, Gibbons was a member of two state semifinal teams (2009 & 2010), earning 2nd team All-State at defensive back. In the opening game of the 2010 season, Gibbons helped the Cougars defeat the St. Ignatius Wildcats at Cleveland Browns Stadium.

Gibbons played collegiately at John Carroll University. As a player with the Blue Streaks, the team made the NCAA Division III playoffs in 2013 and 2014. The 2014 advanced to the national quarterfinal, defeating both Centre College and Wheaton College in the tournament.

Prior to accepting the head coaching job with the Cougars, Gibbons spent the 2017 season as the defensive coordinator at Villa Angela - St. Joseph.

Before his stint at VASJ, he assisted with defensive backs at Notre Dame College (2016) and also helped his brother, Mike Gibbons, at Medina Highland (2015).

Marty Gibbons is the youngest of nine children for John & Patty Gibbons. His brothers, Tom & Mike have coaching roots in Northeast Ohio, as does his brother-in-law, Tom Lombardo.

Another Smith tackle for loss and Davey Ricketts sack would leave the Rebels backed up at their own 10 and the Cougars would take over in great field position after just a 15 yard Rebel punt. Again, the young Cougar offense could not take advantage and turned the ball over on downs. The Rebels would capitalize with a 76 yard touchdown run and successful two point conversion to take a 10-0 lead going into halftime. These were the first points surrendered by the JV defense all season.



Trinetti '25 Claims Another Record

Even as the 2024 season began, Lake Catholic senior Frankie Trinetti had already established himself as one of the best quarterbacks in the school's history, but with one more season to play he could continue to write his name in both the school's and Lake County records hooks

Trinetti already held most of the passing records at Lake Catholic, but there was one record that he was pursuing in his Cougar tenure - - career passing touchdowns.

On Aug. 30, Trinetti threw a touchdown pass of 58 yards to Ace Peterlin in the second quarter, recording his 55th career touchdown pass, tying Pete Jelovic for the school record



pass, passing Jelovic to become the all-time leader at Lake Catholic.

Trinetti is the leader for 12 Lake Catholic passing records, including the career touchdown passes:

Frankie Trinetti (2022-pr) 61 career TD passes Pete Jelovic (1990-92) 55 career TD passes

Trinetti also has an outside chance at becoming Lake County's all-time leader in career passing yards. The Lake County record is currently held by Mentor alum and current Buffalo Bills quarterback, Mitchell Trubisky.

Trubisky threw for 9,126 yards in his high school career (ranking 20th all-time in the state of Ohio) for the Cardinals.

Trinetti has thrown for 5,842 yards (through 4 weeks of the 2024 season) and he needs 3,285 yards passing the remainder of the season to become the Lake County record holder in career passing yards.

Once Trinetti passes the 7,000 career passing yard mark, he will be one of the top 70 all time in the state of Ohio.

Cross Nimmo'25, the 6-foot-6, 230-pound, senior tight end, announced his commitment to the University of Minnesota in April.

Nimmo, a two-way player for the Cougars, had over 800 yards receiving and 15 touchdowns in 2023, plus played defensive end for a Lake Catholic team that made the post-season for just the second time in a dozen years.

Rated three stars by the recruiting services, Nimmo picked the P.J Fleck coached Minnesota Golden Gophers over 12 other programs who offered him full-ride athletic scholarships — including two other Big 10 schools and five of the Mid American Conference teams.


