## **COUGARS KICKOFF NOTES**

The Lake Catholic Cougars look to keep a very special 2024 season going as they host Ravenna in a first-round playoff game at Eastlake North's Nick Carter Stadium on Nov. 1.

Ravenna started the season 1-4 but were able to win three games down the stretch to qualify in Division IV, Region 13 as the final seed in the field. The Ravens have been shut out three times this year and were held to 7 or less two other games. They will need more offense against a dominant Lake Catholic defense.

The Cougars are 10-0 for a lot of reasons, not the least of which is a handful of All-Ohio candidates on offense including QB Frankie Trinetti, wideout Ace Peterlin, tight end Cross Nimmo, offensive lineman Nathan Zappitelli and many other playmakers.

The defense is aggressive and attacking, led by Patrick Radigan, Jayson Cummings and a host of others.

The winner will play either Lutheran East or Mogadore Field on Nov. 8 in Round 2.

**NOTE:** Nick Carter Stadium is located on the campus of Eastlake North High School. Nick Carter Stadium was originally built in 1959. Renovations were completed prior to the 2017 season, which included the installation of artificial turf and new bleacher seating. The stadium is named after former North Athletic Director, Nick Carter; formally dedicated in 1978.

The Cougars had a come-from-behind victory over the Ravenna Ravens, 21-14. With the score tied at 14 late in the fourth quarter on Saturday, senior defensive back Aaron Phillips intercepted a Ravens pass and returned it 43 yards to the Ravenna 34. Two plays later, senior wide receiver Zach Hawkins made his only catch of the night a memorable one. Hawkins grabbed a short pass from QB Mark Baniewicz on a bubble screen, used a stiffarm to avoid a defender, did a 180-degree spin and outraced the defense down the home sideline for the go-ahead 32-yard TD.

On Ravenna's last drive, Hawkins intercepted a pass on Lake's 5-yard line to seal the victory.

Talented junior John Stepec keyed the first scoring drive of the game for the Cougars both offensively and defensively. A sack by Stepec on third down forced a Ravenna punt, and on the ensuing Lake Catholic possession, he plunged for 3 yards on fourth-and-1, then scored on a 2-yard TD run to give the Cougars a 7-0 lead with 30 seconds left in the first quarter.

The Ravens answered early in the second quarter when Brandon Holt hit Jermaine Justice for a 36-yard TD pass to tie the game at 7. After the teams exchanged punts, Lake Catholic pushed back in front with a seven-play drive that started at the Cougars' 46 but covered much more ground because of three consecutive penalties on the home team.

A screen pass to Evan Gormley, and nice runs by Baniewicz and Lou Vettel erased the penalty yardage and put Lake Catholic inside the Ravenna 5. Gormley finished things off with a 2-yard TD scamper around left end for a 14-7 edge. Lake Catholic held the lead until the fourth quarter, when Holt found Matt Thomas for a 13-yard TD pass to tie the game at 14.

After the Cougars had to punt, it appeared the Ravens might be headed for the go-ahead score, but Phillips intercepted Holt and returned it into Ravenna territory to set up the game-winning score for his team

#### THE BEGINNING OF THE NORTH COAST CONFERENCE

The 2024-25 school year brings the beginning of a new league consisting of religious-affiliated schools, named the North Coast Conference. The league was formally announced in May, 2023.

The new league will include Lake Catholic, Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin, Beaumont, and Padua from the Crown Conference, Elyria Catholic and Holy Name from the Great Lakes Conference, and Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy from the Principal's Athletic Conference.

All the schools competed in their old conferences during the 2023-24 school year with North Coast Conference play beginning this fall. Football will be the only exception, as not every school will play each other since most of the 2024 schedules have already been set. Even though there will not be a football league champion in 2024, all-conference honors will be awarded.

"The transition to the North Coast Conference is a great opportunity for Lake Catholic and our partner schools," said Lake Catholic Principal Tom McKrill. "Our students work very hard in the classroom every day, and this will be a great opportunity for our student-athletes to continue to compete with other faith-based schools in interscholastic athletics."



As part of the original renovations of the JTO, the Osborne family earmarked \$750,000 to the Mentor School District to install an artificial turf football field, a new rubberized track and a new scoreboard at the stadium.

Lake Catholic High School also donated \$300,000 to the initial project and the Cougars played the first-ever football game in the renovated stadium on Aug. 26, 2006 against the Euclid Panthers. The facility has a total capacity of 8,000.





Marty Gibbons'11 enters his sixth season as the head coach of his alma mater. Gibbons was hired on November 21, 2018, and took over a program that his father, John Gibbons, led to state championships in 1991 and 1992.

As a player for the Cougars, Gibbons was a member of two state semifinal teams (2009 & 2010), earning 2nd team All-State at defensive back. In the opening game of the 2010 season, Gibbons helped the Cougars defeat the St. Ignatius Wildcats at Cleveland Browns Stadium.

Gibbons played collegiately at John Carroll University. As a player with the Blue Streaks, the team made the NCAA Division III playoffs in 2013 and 2014. The 2014 advanced to the national quarterfinal, defeating both Centre College and Wheaton College in the tournament.

Prior to accepting the head coaching job with the Cougars, Gibbons spent the 2017 season as the defensive coordinator at Villa Angela - St. Joseph.

Before his stint at VASJ, he assisted with defensive backs at Notre Dame College (2016) and also helped his brother, Mike Gibbons, at Medina Highland (2015).

Marty Gibbons is the youngest of nine children for John & Patty Gibbons. His brothers, Tom & Mike have coaching roots in Northeast Ohio, as does his brother-in-law, Tom Lombardo.



#### Trinetti '25 Claims Another Record

Even as the 2024 season began, Lake Catholic senior Frankie Trinetti had already established himself as one of the best quarterbacks in the school's history, but with one more season to play he could continue to write his name in both the school's and Lake County records hooks

Trinetti already held most of the passing records at Lake Catholic, but there was one record that he was pursuing in his Cougar tenure - - career passing touchdowns.

On Aug. 30, Trinetti threw a touchdown pass of 58 yards to Ace Peterlin in the second quarter, recording his 55th career touchdown pass, tying Pete Jelovic for the school record.



Trinetti is the leader for 12 Lake Catholic passing records, including the career touchdown passes:

Frankie Trinetti (2022-pr) **75 career TD passes** Pete Jelovic (1990-92) **55** career TD passes

Trinetti also has an outside chance at becoming Lake County's all-time leader in career passing yards. The Lake County record is currently held by Mentor alum and current Buffalo Bills quarterback, Mitchell Trubisky.

Trubisky threw for 9,126 yards in his high school career (ranking 20th all-time in the state of Ohio) for the Cardinals.

Trinetti has thrown for 7,391 yards (through 10 weeks of the 2024 season) and he needs 1,735 yards passing the remainder of the season to become the Lake County record holder in career passing yards.

Trinetti's 7,391 career passing yards puts him at 58th on the Ohio HS Athletic Association list of all time passers..


