Lake Catholic puts its 3-0 undefeated record on the line in Week 4 as the Cougars host Lake County foe South at the JTO.

The Rebels are 1-2, but coming off a 28-7 win over Brush. This is the youngest team South has fielded in quite some time, with only eight seniors. There are question marks about depth and experience. But the team is physically strong and very athletic. QB Luke Jensen is a sophomore but has a lot of weapons around him including returning starters Mason Matriciano, Brady Namestnik and Drew Vilik at receiver. Three linemen are also returning starters. There are five or six two-way starters, so health is a big key. There are also eight returners on defense.

Lake Catholic has only given up 7 points in three games and were only a few minutes from a shutout at CVCA.

The Cougars are balanced and dangerous on both sides of the ball led by QB Frankie Trinetti, Jimmy Gibbons, Ace Peterlin, D.J. Sears and Cross Nimmo among others. The offensive line is also a strong unit for Coach Marty Gibbons.

"The defense has been phenomenal and the offense is starting to feed off of it. I also think we have gotten some very strong play on special teams so we just have to stay focused and stay balanced in what we do."

"I have known Coach (Matt) Duffy since I was little and he and his staff always do a great job so no way are we getting caught up in records or anything like that. In high school football any time two local teams get together one has the opportunity to step up and play huge so we need to go in ready to play against South."

Lake Catholic fell behind the sticks early on its opening drive in its nonconference matchup at South on Sept. 8. But the Cougars saw their defense respond in kind on the Rebels' opening drive.

After the early hiccup, Lake Catholic found its stride and opened the scoring late in the first quarter. The second saw them put up an insurmountable gap and the Cougars went on to win, 34-7.

The matchup started with both offenses driving down the field, but penalties put them behind the sticks and the defenses forced turnovers on downs.

After the Lake Catholic (3-1) offense got back on the field, they drove 80 yards to open the scoring. From the 1-yard line, DJ Sears punched it in from the stack I formation.

That wasn't the last score for Sears in the first half, as he added two on the receiving end to finish the first half with a trio of scores. The two through the air came on similar play calls, but flipped from one sideline to the other.

The Cougars added one more score in the first half, as Frankie Trinetti found Cross Nimmo on a 53-yard pass. The Cougars lost a fumble in the end zone that South recovered but got the ball right back thanks to a Jimmy Rhodes interception.

Trinetti finished the contest going 14-for-25 for 281 yards and four touchdowns.

The final Lake Catholic touchdown came late in the third quarter as Trinetti rolled out of a stack I formation and found Sears for his third receiving touchdown and fourth of the game. Sears is now the third Cougar in four games to tie the school record for receiving touchdowns in a game.

THE OHSAA FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS REMAIN IN CANTON

In November, 2023, the Ohio High School Athletic Association and the Pro Football Hall of Fame announced a new three-year contract that will keep the OHSAA football state championships in Canton at Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium through 2026.

After Ohio Stadium in Columbus hosted the state championships throughout the 1980s, the finals moved to Massillon and Canton in Stark County from 1990 through 2013. The finals moved back to The Ohio State University from 2014-16, which was also when Fawcett Stadium in Canton was torn down and Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium was built. Tom Benson HOF Stadium has hosted the state finals since 2017, with the exception of 2020 due to the pandemic, when the finals were hosted in Obetz and Massillon.

Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium is a 17,000 seat NFL-caliber stadium surrounded by Hall of Fame Village, a mixed-use development project, that features shopping, entertainment, and dining options.

2024 Independent / 2025 North Coast Conf

The North Coast Conference (Lake Catholic's new athletic conference) will not begin officially sponsoring FOOTBALL until the fall of 2025.

Below are the other five schools that will make up the future NCC, with tracking and comparison information on all six teams.

Also, listed are key games being played by teams in Division IV, Region 13; teams the Cougars will compete against for a post season berth.

THE BEGINNING OF THE NORTH COAST CONFERENCE

The 2024-25 school year brings the beginning of a new league consisting of religious-affiliated schools, named the North Coast Conference. The league was formally announced in May, 2023.

The new league will include Lake Catholic, Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin, Beaumont, and Padua from the Crown Conference, Elyria Catholic and Holy Name from the Great Lakes Conference, and Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy from the Principal's Athletic Conference.

All the schools competed in their old conferences during the 2023-24 school year with North Coast Conference play beginning this fall. Football will be the only exception, as not every school will play each other since most of the 2024 schedules have already been set. Even though there will not be a football league champion in 2024, all-conference honors will be awarded.

"The transition to the North Coast Conference is a great opportunity for Lake Catholic and our partner schools," said Lake Catholic Principal Tom McKrill. "Our students work very hard in the classroom every day, and this will be a great opportunity for our student-athletes to continue to compete with other faith-based schools in interscholastic athletics."

The press box at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is located atop the east side (home side) bleachers. Separate coaches' boxes are available for team personnel only. Media who need working space in the press box should request it through Erik Schroeder or Lea Crowley. Seating will be limited in the press box. For featured games, media members will be assigned seats in the press seating area and seating assignments will be posted throughout the press box.

FIELD MEDIA POLICY

Due to limited space in the press box at Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium, approved media and photographers will be permitted on the sidelines and are expected to honor all sideline policies. Media members and photographers are not allowed in the team bench areas, locker rooms, or other restricted areas in the stadium.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Credentials for photographers will be issued to those representing newspapers, bona fide publications, and other periodicals by Erik Schroeder or Lea Crowley. Please make requests in advance. All photographers are expected to honor all sideline policies and are not permitted in the team bench areas, locker rooms, or other restricted areas within Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium without prior, written authorization from the Lake Catholic Athletic Department.

MEDIA WILL CALL

Approved media or photo credentials can be obtained at the Media Will Call window located at the northwest ticket gate of Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium. The Media Will Call window opens approximately 90 minutes before the game.

LOCKER ROOM POLICY

Lake Catholic High School maintains a closed locker room policy for media at both Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium and on the Lake Catholic High School campus.

TV / RADIO

The Cougars Broadcasting Network and is the official Lake Catholic student streaming broadcast of home games and Spectrum TV is the official television partner of the OHSAA. Both media entities will receive priority seating in the press box.

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium

Jerome T. Osborne, Sr. Stadium is the home to the Lake Catholic Cougars varsity football team. The facility was renovated prior to the start of the 2006 season and has been updated and enhanced prior to 2014 and 2023 seasons. The stadium is often referred to as 'The JTO'.



As part of the original renovations of the JTO, the Osborne family earmarked \$750,000 to the Mentor School District to install an artificial turf football field, a new rubberized track and a new scoreboard at the stadium.

Lake Catholic High School also donated \$300,000 to the initial project and the Cougars played the first-ever football game in the renovated stadium on Aug. 26, 2006 against the Euclid Panthers. The facility has a total capacity of 8,000.

2024 - Week 3 (Sept. 7) Rewind

LAKE CATHOLIC STAYS PERFECT ON SEASON WITH SHUTOUT OF ERIE HIGH

Lake Catholic has played three games, 12 quarters and 144 minutes of football in 2024.

For nearly 140 of those minutes, the opposition has found it impossible to get on the scoreboard.

The Erie Royals learned why as the Cougars shutout the visitors from Pennsylvania in a 37-0 win at the JTO on Sept. 7.

Lake Catholic improved to 3-0 with two shutouts and has outscored the opposition, 84-7.

Jimmy Gibbons scored on a 64-yard run on the first play of the third quarter and the Cougars pounded the ball on the ground against the visiting Royals in the second half.

That touchdown extended Lake's 21-0 halftime lead to 28-0. And after the Cougars' defense forced a turnover on the next possession, the lead grew to 35-0 when Frankie Trinetti hit Ace Peterlin on an 8-yard touchdown pass to create a running-clock situation.

Lake Catholic's defense put the finishing touches on the game when it recorded a safety midway through the fourth quarter.

Lake Catholic (3-0) returns to Jerome T. Osborne Stadium in Week 4 when South visits.

The Cougars established themselves immediately against Erie, with Gibbons scoring on a 2-yard run on the team's opening drive. D.J. Sears rushed in from the 4 early in the second quarter to make it a 14-0 game, a score set up by the passing game when Trinetti (16-25, 195 yards, 2 TDs) found Cross Nimmo on a deep pass down the sideline.

Nimmo then gave Lake a 21-0 lead when he hauled in another pass from Trinetti and dragged two defenders into the end zone with him prior to halftime.

Marty Gibbons'11 enters his sixth season as the head coach of his alma mater. Gibbons was hired on November 21, 2018, and took over a program that his father, John Gibbons, led to state championships in 1991 and 1992.

As a player for the Cougars, Gibbons was a member of two state semifinal teams (2009 & 2010), earning 2nd team All-State at defensive back. In the opening game of the 2010 season, Gibbons helped the Cougars defeat the St. Ignatius Wildcats at Cleveland Browns Stadium.

Gibbons played collegiately at John Carroll University. As a player with the Blue Streaks, the team made the NCAA Division III playoffs in 2013 and 2014. The 2014 advanced to the national quarterfinal, defeating both Centre College and Wheaton College in the tournament.

Prior to accepting the head coaching job with the Cougars, Gibbons spent the 2017 season as the defensive coordinator at Villa Angela - St. Joseph.

Before his stint at VASJ, he assisted with defensive backs at Notre Dame College (2016) and also helped his brother, Mike Gibbons, at Medina Highland (2015).

Marty Gibbons is the youngest of nine children for John & Patty Gibbons. His brothers, Tom & Mike have coaching roots in Northeast Ohio, as does his brother-in-law, Tom Lombardo.

Trinetti '25 Claims Another Record

Even as the 2024 season began, Lake Catholic senior Frankie Trinetti had already established himself as one of the best quarterbacks in the school's history, but with one more season to play he could continue to write his name in both the school's and Lake County records books.

Trinetti already held most of the passing records at Lake Catholic, but there was one record that he was pursuing in his Cougar tenure -- career passing touchdowns.

On Aug. 30, Trinetti threw a touchdown pass of 58 yards to Ace Peterlin in the second quarter, recording his 55th career touchdown pass, tying Pete Jelovic for the school record.

In the second quarter, Trinetti again connected with Ace Peterlin on a long touchdown pass -- this time 71 yards. This was Trinetti's 56th career touchdown pass, passing Jelovic to become the all-time leader at Lake Catholic.

Trinetti is the leader for 12 Lake Catholic passing records, including the career touchdown passes:

Frankie Trinetti (2022-pr) 58 career TD passes
Pete Jelovic (1990-92) 55 career TD passes

Trinetti also has an outside chance at becoming Lake County's all-time leader in career passing yards. The Lake County record is currently held by Mentor alum and current Buffalo Bills quarterback, Mitchell Trubisky.

Trubisky threw for 9,126 yards in his high school career (ranking 19th all-time in the state of Ohio) for the Cardinals.

Trinetti has thrown for 5,644 yards (through 3 weeks of the 2024 season) and he needs 3,483 yards passing the remainder of the season to become the Lake County record holder in career passing yards.

The Sullivan name is synonymous with Lake Catholic football and wrestling, and Mark is a big reason why.



He was voted a First Team All-State Class AAA Defensive player in 1977.

Then Youngstown Mooney player, and now Hall of Fame Collegiate Coach, Bob Stoops has publicly said that his biggest regret in football was losing to Lake Catholic during the 1977 season.

Even though his team went on to win the Class AA state championship, Stoops lamented how his coaches refused to double-team Mark Sullivan and how he completely dominated the game.

Later during his senior year, Mark also became an All-Ohioan in wrestling, when he placed third in the Class AAA state tournament.

DAN WELLY '81

During his senior year, Dan Welly was the first three- sport captain in school history, leading the football, basketball and baseball teams.



He was a great leader, teammate and friend to everyone his teams.

Dan was an all-state linebacker during his senior season, and led the Cougars to victory over then-rival St. Edward for the first time ever.

With Lake Catholic trailing 15-6, Dan scooped up a blocked punt and scored a touchdown midway through the fourth quarter.

And then with just seven seconds left in the game, he blocked St. Ed's field goal attempt, securing the 16-15 win.
