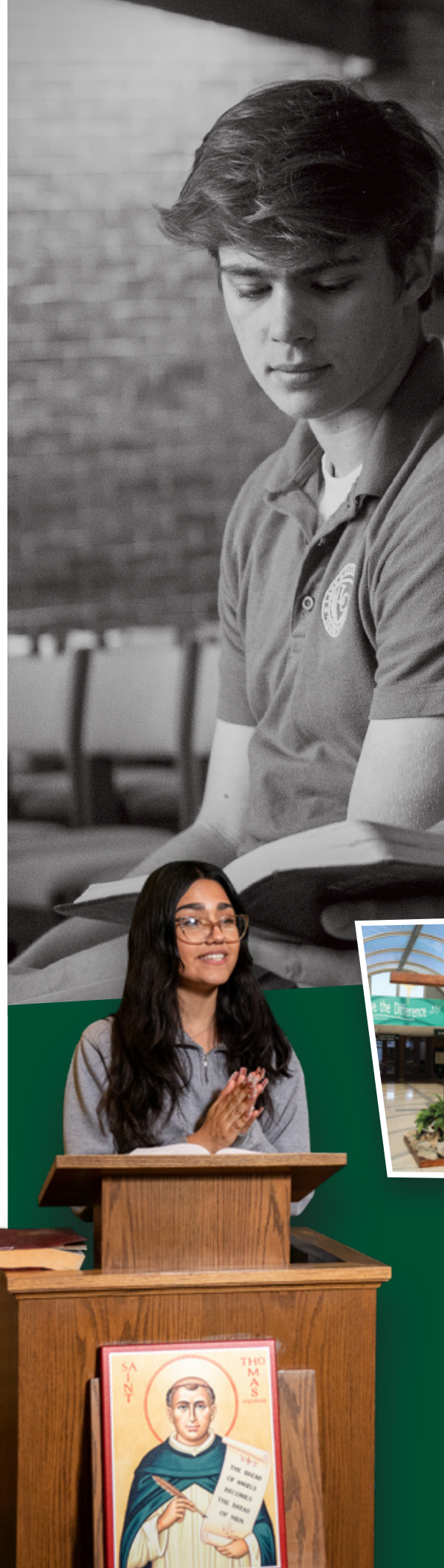

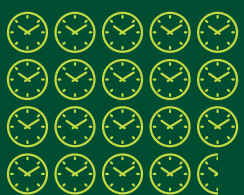

**Hands-on learning** is the best learning – allowing you to apply the knowledge you gain from your teachers in ways that are tangible, challenging, **rewarding...and fun.**

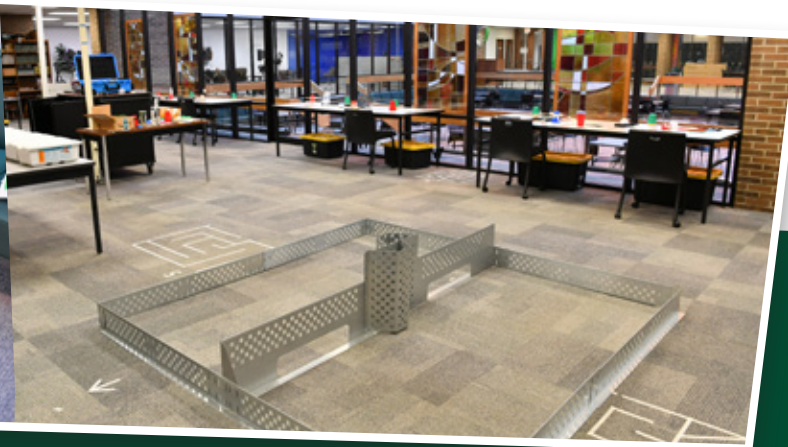

The placement exam is offered in-person at Lake Catholic and may be taken on any of the dates listed above for scholarship consideration. Sign-up is available through the Lake Catholic website. Scholarships will be awarded to top scorers.

Students can take their placement exam as part of their shadow day and still be considered for scholarships as long as it is before November 9, 2023. Let the Admissions department know if you would like this option.

### **TUITION AND FINANCIAL AID**

- Tuition for the 2023-2024 school year is \$11,450
- More than 68% of families receive financial aid
- In order to be considered for financial aid for the 2023–24 school year, a FACTS application must be completed

### **COUGAR ELITE SCHOLARSHIP**

The Cougar Elite Scholarship is offered to individuals who test in the highest percentiles on our Placement Exam. Final test date to be considered for this scholarship is November 9, 2023.

### **STATE SCHOLARSHIPS**

Lake Catholic is proud to accept the EdChoice, EdChoice Expansion, and Jon Peterson Scholarships, provided by the Ohio Department of Education.

### **MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS**

Lake Catholic's Scholarship Committee will review all accepted student files to review for any possible merit awards. External merit scholarships will be announced to families by Lake Catholic as they become available.
