

The Mary T. Zappitelli Scholarship at Lake Catholic High School



The Mary Zappitelli Scholarship Fund was established in 2015 by the Zappitelli family; husband Frank, daughter Danielle '00, and sons Steven '04 and Michael '06. Mrs. Zappitelli passed away after a courageous battle with cancer in November 2015.

Candidates for this scholarship should exemplify Mary's qualities that she demonstrated while being a Spanish teacher for 17 years at Lake Catholic High School, as well as the Spirit Rally Advisor, Senior Class Moderator and Student Government Advisor. Mary was someone that lit up the hallways of the school daily with her infectious smile and laughter. Mary focused and preached "treat others as you would like to be treated."

Mary also created a hand mural at St. Mary of the Assumption School where she worked as the art teacher for many years prior. She strongly encouraged the phrase to her students "Hand in hand, together, we are one in Christ," which proudly is written in the center of the mural.

Mrs. Zappitelli's faith guided her positive attitude. She used her faith to project strength and kindness towards others. The scholarship applicants should exemplify and provide examples and situations which reflect Mary's characteristics. Where strength was shown in times when faith in Christ was tested and situations where kindness was shown to others.

The Mary T. Zappitelli Scholarship will award two scholarships of \$1,000 each to two current Lake Catholic High School students. The scholarship will be applied to the tuition of the selected recipients for the 2021-2022 school year. To be considered for the scholarship, there are three essay questions to complete, which are located on the back of this form.

Timeline for the Application Process:

- Submit application and essays to Lake Catholic on or before **FRIDAY, JANUARY 7, 2022**
- Finalists will be selected and asked to interview with the Scholarship Committee at Lake Catholic during the month of January 2022
- Awards will be made prior to the Lake Catholic Scholarship Mass/Reception in February 2021
